In this role, you would be responsible for organizing, coordinating, coaching, implementing, monitoring, and reporting on the Environment, Health and Safety Management Program for the project.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Act as onsite resource for all safety related matters

- Work closely with the Construction Management Team to promote a total environmental, health and safety culture
- Develop site specific safety plans for construction projects in line with ATCO and client program requirements which follow ATCO and the Client safety plans
- Implement and manage incident prevention processes and strategies
- Develop, evaluate, revise and communicate construction specific HSE job safety analysis as required
- Track and report leading and lagging indicators
- Conduct root cause incident investigations and monitor follow-up activities to ensure timely completion
- Coordinate new hire site accesses and requirements
- Coordinate and conduct safety orientation and training programs for staff and contractors
- Develop and conduct daily tool box discussions and weekly safety meetings for larger groups of employees
- Review contractor HSE programs and documentation to determine compliance with ATCO and project HSE requirements
- Respond to work site emergencies
- Administer project specific crisis management and emergency response plans
- Encourage reporting, investigation and evaluation of all HSE incidents and recommends corrective action to prevent future occurrences
- Perform site inspections, identify corrective and preventative measures and follow-up
- Report, investigate and ensure sign off all incidents and make recommendations for corrective actions to prevent future occurrences
- Complete internal audit, inspections and observations
- Assist in external audit process
- Evaluate workplace procedures to revise current physical demand and job safety analysis
- Act as a resource and provide expert advice to various groups on solving issues and concerns with respect to the Occupational Health and Safety Act and company policies and procedures
- Other duties as assigned
