**Responsibilities:**

- Responsible for moving supplies, equipment and people to and from construction sites
- Operate in a wide variety of weather, traffic and general road conditions

- Must load trucks to maximize the use of space, distribute weight accordingly and employ proper load securement procedures to ensure safety on the road
- Conduct pre-trip equipment and load securement inspections, safety checks and inspections and, if necessary, make roadside adjustments and repairs
- Must comply with National Safety Code provisions

**Requirements:**

- Must possess appropriate Provincial Class License for truck being driven (Generally Class 1 or 3 with an Air Brake endorsement; dependent on vehicle configuration)
- Experience driving Winch, Skid, Texas Bed, Lowboy, Fuel, Lube, NCS Truck Drivers and Bus drivers.
- Must successfully complete pre-employment drug and alcohol testing.
- Must have a valid Transportation of Dangerous Goods certificate.
- Must have directly related experience in heavy equipment hauling, winching operations and/or other oilfield related trucking experience.
- Leadership experience in a related field will be an asset.
- Must have a valid Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG) Certification
- In BC, Picker Truck or Boom Truck Operators must be certified or registered for assessment by the British Columbia Association for Crane Safety (BCACS)
- Clean driver's abstract required
