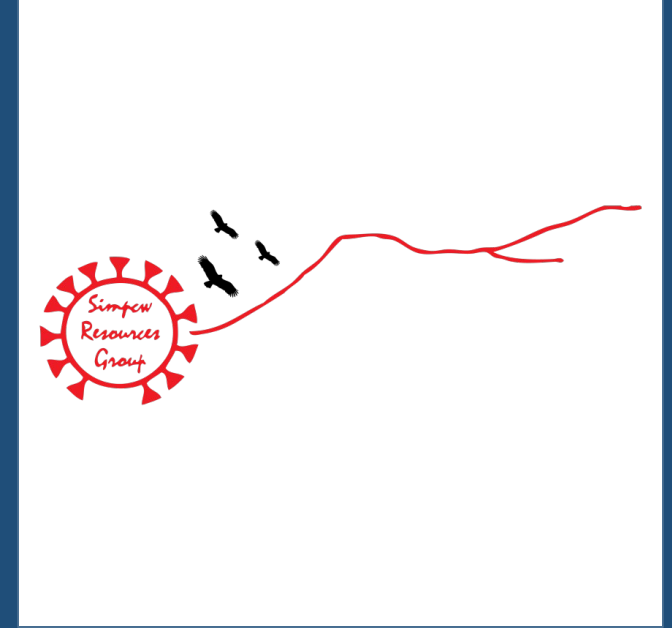

The Purpose of Simpcw Resources LLP (SRLLP)

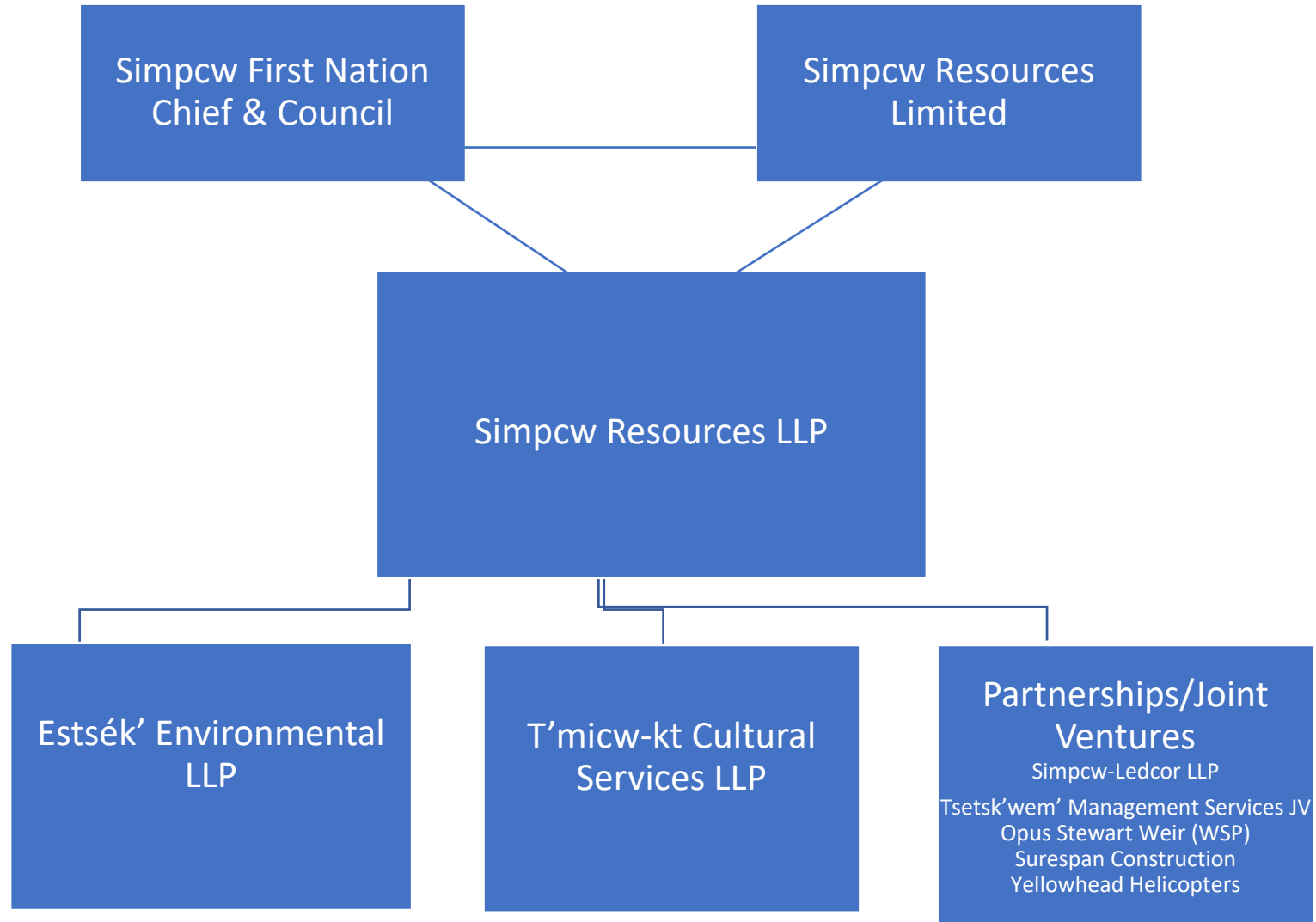
Is to help create a community that fosters respect, pride and self-sufficiency using sustainable and environmentally responsible methods that honour the culture of Simpcw First Nation.

SRG Role within the Mutual Benefit Agreement (MBA)

Simpcw First Nation (SFN) has appointed SRG as the responsible coordinator (Coordinator) for the development and implementation of the business opportunities initiatives related to the Trans Mountain Expansion Project as outlined in the MBA. Business Opportunities awarded under the MBA must be awarded through the Coordinator.

The Coordinator, working in cooperation with SFN is responsible for:

- developing and maintaining a registry of Simpcw Businesses interested in obtaining Business Opportunities for the Project;
- assisting Simpcw Businesses in obtaining pre-qualification status for specific scopes of work related to the Project;
- ensuring Simpcw Businesses are made aware of requests for proposals and assisting in coordinating the submission of bids by Simpcw Businesses; and
- working with Trans Mountain Corporation to facilitate the exchange of information and ensure the processes set out in the MBA are carried out.

SRG Involvement in Trans Mountain Expansion Project

SRG is currently involved in the following activities associated with the Trans Mountain Expansion Project:

- Maintain/Update Simpcw Business Directory
- Simpcw Member Employment Training Courses
- Liaison with Trans Mountain Corporation and Prime Contractors
- Coordinate and respond to Pre qualification and RFP requests
- Evaluate and manage risk associated with business opportunities
- Actively market and promote Simpcw Business capacity

SRG Business Opportunity Hierarchy

SRG business opportunities are conducted according to this hierarchy:

1. Complete with existing SRLLP resources and partnerships if business opportunity is within SRG scope of services.
2. SRLLP acquires additional resources to expand SRG scope of services to deliver business opportunity.
3. SRLLP requests additional resources from Simpcw Business Registry and ARMS database to expand SRG scope of services to deliver on business opportunity.
4. SRLLP tender's potential business opportunity to qualified Simpcw Businesses as the opportunity is outside SRG scope of services
5. SRLLP passes on business opportunity as it is outside of SRG and Simpcw Business scope of services.

SRG Tender Evaluation Process

In situations where a request for proposal is competitive, SRG employs a Tender Evaluation Process that is evaluated by SRG senior staff including a Management Committee member. Proposal scores are based on:

- Completeness
- Price
- Completion of similar projects (last 5 years)
- Financial Capacity
- Safety
- Simpcw Business (demonstrated control and decision making by a Simpcw Member or entity)
